



THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF KING

BY-LAW NUMBER 2016-32

A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 2014-120 BEING A BY-LAW TO DEFINE THE PROCUREMENT POLICIES AND PROCEDURES FOR THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF KING HEREAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE “TOWNSHIP”

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 391 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, provides that a Municipality shall adopt policies with respect to its procurement of goods, services, and construction;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of King **HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. **THAT** By-law 2014-120, referred to as the “Procurement By-law”, was enacted on November 17, 2014.
2. **THAT** Section 9.4 Non-Competitive Procurement Methods, Paragraph f) Sole Source Purchase, sub-paragraph ii. be amended as follows:

Remove:

Where Goods are offered for sale to the Corporation by bid, auction or negotiation such purchase will be deemed to be a Sole Source Purchase and the Chief Administrative Officer may authorize the submission of a Bid or the conduct of negotiations where the Chief Administrative Officer determines the purchase to be clearly in the best interest of the Corporation;

Replace with:

Where Goods and Services are offered for sale to the Corporation by bid, auction or negotiation such purchase will be deemed to be a Sole Source Purchase and the Chief Administrative Officer may authorize the submission of a Bid or the conduct of negotiations where the Chief Administrative Officer determines the purchase to be clearly in the best interest of the Corporation;

3. **THAT** this By-law shall come into effect on the 22nd day of March, 2016.

READ a **FIRST** and **SECOND** time this 21st day of March, 2016.

READ a **THIRD** time and **FINALLY PASSED** this 21st day of March, 2016.
