Transportation improvements prepare York Region to meet the needs of motorists, cyclists, pedestrians and transit users, today and into the future.



DESCRIPTION

Road improvements

- Removing and replacing the road surface
- Replacing storm sewers and catch basins
- Building a multi-use path and installing new lighting on the east side of the road from Morning Sideroad to the commercial plaza
- Upgrading the church and commercial plaza intersection to meet *Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act* requirements

This is the first phase of construction which is expected to start in June 2024 and be completed in October 2024. More project details are available at york.ca/Highway11

The road will remain open to through traffic; however, lane restrictions are required to safely complete this work. Access to homes and businesses will be maintained.

Lane reductions limited to:

- Monday to Friday 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
- Weeknights from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. for major works such as paving

As with all road construction projects, work may be rescheduled due to weather. York Region will provide advance notice where possible. Thank you for your patience during the construction period. We understand road construction creates challenges for the community and we are working to deliver this project with minimal disruption.
